Stricken While Returning From Funeral of Son-in-Law

Mrs. Mary Stelle Lewis familiarly known to many residents of northeast Washington as "Aunt Mary," died Tuesday at Sibley Hospital following a short illness. Funeral services will be held at her home, 1103 Florida avenue northeast, tomorrow morning, conducted by Rev. Paul Serry. Interment will be at Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Lewis was taken ill suddenly while returning from the funeral of her son-in-law, William Clore, who died last week of Spanish influenza. She is survived by her husband, W Fred Lewis; two sons, Lieut. Jack Lewis and Robert S. Lewis, and a daughter, Miss Stelle Lewis.
