H.E. Lineaweaver Dead

Former D.C. Resident, Who Expired in Pittsburgh, Buried Here

Henry E. Lineaweaver, formerly of the District of Columbia, died suddenly in Pittsburgh, Pa., September 7. Following services there, services were held here last Tuesday.

Mr. Lineaweaver was graduated from the National University Law School here in 1892, and the following year entered the law office of Stone and Potter, at Pittsburgh, later becoming a member of the firm.
