

William A. Linton **(1791 - 26 Sep 1867)**

William A. Linton, Esq., an old citizen of Washington, died at his residence, on C street, between First and Second streets, on Tuesday night at 1 1/2 o'clock. Mr. Linton was born in Dumfries, Va., in 1791, was educated at the college of William and Mary, in that State, studied the legal profession in his native village, and removed to this city in 1835, where he has resided ever since. He was rendered quite deaf when about twenty-five years of age, which incapacitated him thenceforth from the practice of his profession. The deceased was well and favorably known among our citizens, by whom he was universally esteemed. He was seventy-six years of age. The funeral will take place today at 3 o'clock, from his late residence.
