Death of J.L. Little

The funeral of Jesse Lee Little, who died at the home of his mother, on I street southeast, Saturday last, took place yesterday afternoon from his late residence, No. 608 I street southeast, with a large attendance of his relatives, friends and scholars. The deceased who was a son of the late John E. Little, was well and favorably unknown by the old residents of the Navy Yard section of Capitol Hill, from his birth, which occurred some forty odd years ago, within a stone's throw of the place of his death. Mr. Little's youthful days were spent as an apprentice in the shipjoiners' shop of the Washington Navy Yard, but upon reaching his majority, owing to ill health, he abandoned his trade and devoted the balance of his life to teaching music.
