Mrs. Livingston, Fifth-Generation Resident of D.C.

Mrs. Louise Traylor Livingston, 73, a fifth-generation Washingtonian, died Tuesday at Doctors Hospital after a short illness.

Mrs. Livingston, who worked for the Garfinckel Co. for 17 years before her retirement in the early 1950s, was the wife of LeRoy Livingston, a manufacturer's representative here. He died in 1938. She was the granddaughter of the late Samuel C. Mills, a judge in the District's Municipal Court, and a great-niece of Joseph B. Tate, a founder of The Star.

Mr. Livingston, of 2320 Nebraska avenue N.W., leaves a son, Robert LeRoy, of the home address; a brother, A. Mills Traylor of Sarasota, Fla., and two grandchildren.

Services will be at 10 a.m. tomorrow at the Gawler funeral home, Wisconsin avenue at Harrison street N.W. Burial in Congressional Cemetery will be private.
