Nathaniel Loveless, 66, an employe of Peoples Drug Stores, died yesterday in Emergency Hospital. He lied at 4906 Ninth street N.W.

Mr. Loveless worked for the last two years in the cigar department of the drugstore at 1107 Pennsylvania avenue N.W. Prior to 1943 he was with the Safeway Stores for 10 years. Born in Prince Georges County, Md., he came to Washington 27 years ago and for seeral years operated his own grocery business.

He was a member of the Woodmen of the World.
