George W. Lockett Dies

Veteran Street Railway Employe Succumbs to Illness

George W. Lockett, 76 years of age, life-long resident of this city and half century employe of both street railway lines died yesterday at his home, 818 Sixth street northeast, following a month's illness.

Mr. Lockett was born here April 25, 1850. He married Miss Josephine Turnburke of Washington, and would have celebrated his golden wedding anniversary June 28. For 50 years Mr. Lockett was connected with the Washington Railway & Electric Co. and the Capital Traction Co., retiring from the former several years ago. He was a charter member of Union Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, having been a member of that organization for 52 years.

Surviving him are his wife, four sons and five daughters.

Funeral services will be conducted by the lodge members and officiated by Rev. Dr. Abbot, pastor of the Church of the Good Shepherd, at the residence, Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock.
