Mrs. Theresa Fenton Lockett, sixty-four years old, died at her home, 127 10th street northeast, late yesterday afternoon. She was the wife of Thomas T. Lockett. Funeral services are to be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the residence. Interment is to be in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Lockett was born in this city, and had lived here all her life. She was the daughter of Charles Wesley Fenton, consul to Leeds, England, before the civil war. Mrs. Lockett was a member of the First Presbyterian Church. Besides her husband, five children, Thomas I. Lockett, H.M. Lockett, Dr. Daniel G. Lockett, Miss Ella Lockett and Mrs. C.L. Constantini, survive her.
