A Military Funeral

The funeral of the late Mr. C.B. Lusby took place at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon from St. Mark's Episcopal church, East Washington, Rev. A.F. Steele reading the service. The interment was made in the Congressional cemetery, the cortege being a large one. Kit Carson Post No. 2, G.A.R., Commander G.M. Husted and fifty comrades, and the Union Veteran corps. Lieutenant M.E. Urell and forty-five members, formed an escort. Military honors were paid to the deceased at the grave, the veterans firing three volleys of twelve shots each over it. The pall-bearers were John Middleton, D. O'Neil, E.H. Curry, F.D. Neale and E.C. Stevens
