Charles A. Lyons, Veteran, 69, Dies

Charles A. Lyons, 69, of 1369 Meridian place N.W., a retired employe of the Washington Navy Yard and native of this city, died yesterday in the Washington Sanitarium Hospital, Takoma Park, Md., after a long illness.

Mr. Lyons, a veteran of the Spanish American War was past commander of Dewey Camp, United Spanish American War Veterans, and also was active in the Veterans of Foreign Wars. He was the son of the late Daniel Rufus Alexander Lyons and the late Mrs. Susan Boswell Lyons. His parents formerly were of Maryland.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Abner H. Ferguson; a son, Charles A. Lyons, jr., and a granddaughter, Miss Margaret Lee Lyons, all of this city, and a sister, who lives in Philadelphia.

Private funeral services will be held tomorrow in the Zurhorst funeral parlors.
