Child's Burns Prove Fatal

Dorothy McKenzie Dies at Hospital. Played With Matches.

Dorothy McKenzie, eight years old, who was burned while playing with matches in her home, 128 E street southeast, last Friday, died this morning at Providence Hospital.

The child with two other children, procured matches, and were lighting them when the flames set fire to her clothing. Before the flames could be extinguished she had been severely burned. She was rushed to the hospital, but her condition was such that little hope was held for her recovery. She died at 11 o'clock this morning.
