The Harlan County News is an ably edited newspaper published here by Flavius Macmillan. The News was established in Republican City, by its present publisher in 1875, and was published here until the fall of 1881 when it was removed to Alma.

William G. Cutler's History of the State of Kansas, 1883

In September of the same year (1872) the Sentinel was sold to Flavius J. McMillan, a young attorney from Boston, who conducted it until the spring of 1874 when he moved it to Phillipsburg, and commenced publication of a paper at that place, the history of which will be found in the history of Phillips County.
