Death of Mrs. MacNichol

Mrs. Annie M. MacNichol, wife of Mr. Frank A. MacNichol, died this morning at 5 o'clock at her residence, 105 C street southeast.

Mrs. MacNichol had been ill for the past year, and while her death was not unexpected, it proved a great shock to her friends. She was in the 27th year of her age and had been a resident of this city for the past twelve years, having removed here from Dayton, Va., her birthplace. She was of a pleasant and charitable disposition and an earnest worker in St. Mark's Protestant Episcopal Church, of which she was a member. Her husband and a daughter two years old survive her.

Funeral services will be held Monday, November 6, at 2 o'clock p.m. at her late residence. Rev. W. Devriews, pastor of St. Mark's Church, will officiate. The interment, which will be private, will be in Congressional cemetery.
