Frank McCathran Buried

Services Held Thursday With Interment in Congressional Cemetery

Funeral services for Frank McCathran, civil war veteran, who died Sunday, October 28, were held Thursday at his late residence, 718 North Carolina avenue southeast. Interment was in Congressional cemetery.

Mr. McCathran served meritoriously during the civil war, being awarded a medal for saving the battleship Wyoming from destruction by fire. He was a boilermaker on the ship. Mr. McCathran was sixty years old and is survived by his wife and one daughter, Mrs. Charles Dietz, jr.

He was a member of Naval Lodge, No. 4; Washington Naval Chapter, No. 6; Orient Commandery, No. 5; Knights Templar, the Ashlar Club, Order of the Eastern Star and the Knights of Pythias.
