Funeral

The funeral of Dr. J.W. McCauley took place from his residence, 1256 Eighth street northwest, yesterday afternoon, and was largely attended by Hope Lodge 20, F. and A.M. and Mount Vernon Lodge No.. 5, Knights of Pythias. The latter-named lodge were in the new uniform of the Order, and looked remarkably well. they were marshaled by P.G.C. Thomas Hamilton. The cortege, headed by Allen's band, proceeded to Congressional cemetery, where deceased was interred with the funeral ceremonies of the above-named Orders, P.C. Edw. Lacy officiating from the K. of P.
