Death of Miss McCauley

Miss J.P. McCauley died at her father's residence at 2:40 p.m. Friday. She was educated in the public schools of Washington, and, after having graduated from the Normal School, was appointed the following year a teacher, in which capacity she has served successfully and conscientiously for more than 25 years. She had been a member and corresponding secretary of the Amidon Association since its formation. Miss McCauley had been failing for several months, and while a great shock to her many friends, her death was not unexpected.
