Mrs. Daisy E. McClure Dead

Daughter of Lieut. Wm. A. Duvall Passes Away

Mrs. Daisy E. McClure, daughter of First Lieut. Wm. A. Duvall, quartermaster, 3d Battalion, D.C.N.G., and superintendent of the National Guard armory, died at 8 o'clock yesterday morning at her home, Williamstown, N.J., of typhoid-pneumonia. Deceased was the wife of Dr. James C. McClure, a practicing physician of Williamstown.

Lieut. Duvall and Mrs. Duvall were summoned when a change for the worse in the condition of the patient was noted, but they were unable to reach Williamstown until 9 o'clock, an hour after their daughter passed away.

The remains will arrive here at 11:30 o'clock tomorrow morning and the funeral is to occur from the residence of Lieut. Duvall, 704 6th street, at 2:30 o'clock Tuesday afternoon. The interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
