Two Boys Drowned In Local Waters

H.H. Hanson and Leroy McGill Victims of Boating and Bathing Accidents

The McGill boy, who lived at 760 6th street southeast, was drowned in the Eastern branch near the foot of E street northeast while bathing with several companions. One of them made an effort to save him, but the swift current counteracted the attempted rescue, Geroge Ratherdale recovered the body several hours after the accident and the coroner gave a certificate of accidental drowning. Mrs. Lillian Meir, mother of the boy, underwent an operation at the Emergency Hospital yesterday and was not told of the fatality. The deceased was a sixth-grade pupil in the Lenox School and was a member of the Boy Scouts.
