Funeral of Howard McLellan

The funeral of the late Howard McLellan took place Sunday afternoon, from the residence of his parents, and was attended by a large concourse of relatives and friends. The religious services were conducted by Rev. Mr. Howlett, of the Cavalry Baptist Church, and before the lid of the coffin was screwed down the friends of the deceased were allowed to take a farewell look at the features of one whom they had loved and respected in life. The coffin was of black walnut, trimmed with white satin, mounted with silver handles, and on the lid a beautiful plate of silver, bearing the inscription, "Howard McLellan, died March 18, 1861, aged 25 years." The pall bearers were Mr. Van Buskirk, Mr. Mattingly, Mr. King, Mr. G. Wood, Mr. Henry Wood, and Mr. Tipkin. The remains of the deceased were interred in the Congressional Cemetery.
