Dr. Milburn Dead

Druggist Suddenly Expires at Early Hour This Morning

Dr. Louis Calvert Milburn, druggist, of 731 7th street southwest, died suddenly this morning about 2:30 o'clock. Shortly before his heavy breathing alarmed a friend with whom he spent the night, and when the latter felt his pulse he discovered his critical condition and a physician was summoned.
