Marguerite Miller, of Old D.C. Family

Marguerite Depue Miller, 81, a member of an old Washington family and widow of The Star's first classified advertising manager, died of cancer yesterday in the Woodbine Nursing Home in Alexandria. She lived on N. Jackson Street in Arlington.

Mrs. Miller was born in Southwest Washington, where her grandfather, Charles Benjamin Church, had built many homes on the site now occupied by the L'Enfant Plaza development.

Her husband, Neville D., was classified advertising manager of The Star from 1922 until his death in 1950.

For many years Mrs. Miller was a member of Westminster Presbyterian Church here, but after moving to Arlington she joined Clarendon Presbyterian Church. For two years she was president of the Women's Association of the Clarendon church.

She leaves a son, Davidson C., of Arlington, four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Saturday in Clarendon Presbyterian Church, 1301 N. Jackson St., Arlington, with burial in Congressional Cemetery.
