## **Thomas Miller**

Departed this life suddenly, in this City, about 8 o'clock in the evening of the 26th instant, Major Thomas Miller, aged 70 years; a native of the town of Port Royal, in the State of Virginia, and long one of the most enterprising, highly respected, and valuable residents of that town. Major Miller became a resident of this City about 12 years since, and has, during the greater part of that time acted as a Clerk in the Navy Department. The writer of this hasty notice has known the deceased intimately, more than half a century, and is warranted in saying, that no individual ever did possess, in a higher degree than he did, all those moral and social qualities, which constitute and characterize the good man and good citizen. He has left a beloved wife, a large family of children and grand-children, and an extensive circle of devoted friends, to lament the loss of this important link in the chain of their affections and long established friendship. The funeral of the deceased will take place, at his late residence on 13th Street, at 12 o'clock This Day.
