### **W.P. Miller Found Dead**

#### **Coroner Thinks Conditions Indicated Suicide**

The body of William P Miller, sixty years of age, was found yesterday in his room at 707 D street northwest. Death resulted from his having inhaled illuminating gas. Conditions indicate suicide.

Coroner Nevitt, who started an investigation, was told that the transom over the door was found closed while usually it had been kept open, and the window was also closed, preventing the escape of gas.

Miller left no note of explanation. The coroner said the conditions indicated that he had committed suicide, but he will make a further investigation before issuing a certificate of death.

It is thought that Miller formerly resided in Hagerstown, Md.
