Death of Mrs. Mills

The death of Mrs. Mary Ann Mills occurred on Thursday at the residence in Chicago of one of her daughters. The deceased was the widow of Capt. John Mills, who was at one time the captain of the Auxiliary Guard, the police organization which preceded the establishment of the metropolitan police force. Mrs. Mills came to this city in 1833, and resided here until about two years ago. Her sons--Judge S.C. Mills and Capt. John H. Mills--are the only members of the family of the deceased now residing in this city. The remains of Mrs. Mills will be laid to rest in the family lot in the Congressional cemetery.
