Death of Charles F. Moore

Information has been received in this city of the death of Charles F. Moore, assistant custodian of the federal building at Buffalo, N.Y., who died at the Frontier Hospital in that city January 15. Mr. Moore for several years conducted a pharmacy in this city. He became a resident of Buffalo in 1897, when he was appointed assistant to the superintendent of construction of the federal building. When the building was finished he was made assistant custodian. Deceased was seventy-two years of age and a native of Augusta, Me. He was connected with Hiram Lodge, No. 10, F.A.A.M., of this city, as well as a number of other fraternal organizations in Buffalo. His wife and one son, Walter S. Moore of Oil City, Pa., survive him.
