Sudden Death of an Estimable Young Man

On Saturday last, Mr. John F. Moore, son of Capt. W.W. Moore, Alderman from the Fourth Ward, died quite suddenly at his boarding house, corner of 9th and H streets. Mr. Moore was a clerk in the General Land Office, and although in very delicate health was accustomed to attend at his office every day. On Friday he was at the office as usual, and was assisted to his home by one of his fellow clerks. While preparing to go to his office on Saturday he became so weak that he was forced to lay down, and in about an hour breathed his last. His disease was consumption. The funeral took place this afternoon from his father's residence.
