### **Funeral of John A. Moran**

#### **Services Are Held at St. Joseph's Catholic Church**

Funeral services were held this morning at St. Joseph's Catholic Church for John A. Moran, who died Monday. Rev. Ignatius Fealy officiated. The pallbearers were Charles Shelse, William Schofield, Henry Hendrick and Andrew Oehmann.

Mr. Moran was for many years employed in the adjutant general's office of the War Department as translator. Recently he had been employed at the Home Savings Bank. He was born in London England, December 7, 1850, and came to the United States when he was about eighteen years old. He had resided in Washington for thirty-seven years. In 1884 he was married to Miss Isabelle Stockett.

A daughter, Miss N. Eileen Moran, survives him. His only son, Francis Stockert Moran, died seventeen months ago, and since that time Mr. Moran's health had been failing.
