### **Two Inquests Today In Traffic Accidents**

#### **Details to Be Presented in Cases of Edward W. Kobl and Mrs. Margaret Morris**

Inquests in two fatal traffic accidents are scheduled to be held at the morgue late today.

The second inquest will be held over the body of Mrs. Margaret Morris, twenty years old, 320 9th street southeast, who was injured Friday morning as a result of a collision between an automobile and a vehicle of the street cleaning department at Pennsylvania avenue and 9th street.

Mrs. Morris, accompanied by her sister, Miss Helen Hayre, and two young men, was returning home in an automobile when the collision occurred. She was the only one who received serious injuries.
