Morris. In Philadelphia, suddenly on Monday, December 7, 1896, Robert Murray, brevet lieutenant colonel, U.S.A., son of the late Commodore Charles Morris, U.S.N. Funeral services from the residence of his sister, 1515 L street northwest, on Wednesday morning, December 9, at 11 o'clock. Interment private.

Born DC, appointed DC. Cadet Military Academy July 1, 1841 to Jan. 17, 1842; 2d Lt. Mounted Rifle May 27, 1846; 1 Lt. June 8, 1848; RQM Oct. 5, 1854 to Feb. 1, 1855; Capt. June 14, 1858; 3d Cavalry Aug. 3, 1861; Maj. 6th Cavalry, March 11, 1863; retired Feb. 21, 1873; Bvt. 1 Lt. Aug. 20, 1847 for gallant and meritorious conduct in the battle of Contreras, Mexico; Capt. Sept. 13, 1847 for gallant and meritorious conduct in the battle of Chapultepec, Mexico; Major Feb. 21, 1862 for and meritorious service in the battle of Valverde, New Mexico, and Lt. Col. March 31, 1865 for gallant and meritorious service in the battle of Dinwiddie Court House, Va.; died Dec. 7, 1896.
