Jacob C. Mueller Dies Here, Aged 72

Member of Board of Directors of German Orphan Asylum. Funeral to Be Friday

Jacob C. Mueller, member of the Board of Directors of the German Orphan Asylum, died yesterday afternoon at his home, 906 South Carolina avenue southeast. Mr. Mueller, who was 72, had lived in Washington since he was 17, when he came here, alone, from his native Germany. He was born in Ruppurr.

For a time he worked for his brother, who had established a grocery business. Later he set up his own store, retiring in 1913. He married the late Louisa K. Ermold in 1887.

Particularly interested in the German Orphan Asylum, Mr. Mueller devoted the last part of his life to charitable work of all sorts. He is survived by a son, George J. Mueller.

Funeral services will be conducted at the home Friday at 2 p.m. by Rev. Frederick Enders of Concordia Church. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
