Mrs. Sophia Naecker, 77, widow of Ludwig Naecker, for many years well known in local music circles, died Tuesday night at her home, 2417 T street southeast. She was a lifelong resident of this city.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. William Towne, Mrs. J. Michael Newcomb and Mrs. Samuel Roberts and three sons, John, Louis and William Naecker.

Mrs. Naecker was a graduate of the first Washington Conservatory of Music in 1875, and later taught here.

Funeral services will be conducted at St. Francis Xavier Church tomorrow morning, with a Requiem High Mass sung by Rev. Joseph V. Buckley. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
