Charles M. Nicholson Funeral Today

Charles M. Nicholson, 82, retired Navy Yard employe, who died Sunday, was to be buried in Congressional Cemetery following funeral services this afternoon at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Harry Daniels, 1240 Eleventh street S.E.

The Rev. George H. Bennett, pastor of the Wilson Memorial Presbyterian Church, was to officiate.

Mr. Nicholson, a lifelong resident of Washington, formerly was a member of the Metropolitan Police force. His son, Paul W. Nicholson, is employed in the Detective Bureau.

In 1883 Mr. Nicholson married Mary E. Kyle. She died in 1925. Other survivors include three daughters, Mrs. Harry Estep, Mrs. Harry Odell and Mrs. Lawrence Warner, and another son, Charles M. Nicholson, jr., all of this city.
