The Will of the late Phillip Otterback has been proved before Judge Purcell of the Orphan's Court. The estate is very large. The widow is left the whole estate during her life of widowhood, except some small legacies to the children and the "White House" estate, which is left in trust to Levi Burk, of Virginia, for the use of his (Otterback's) heirs. The Judge has given Mrs. Otterback until Saturday next to give bond and qualify as executor.
