## Joseph W. Palmer Dies

## Long-Time Employe of G.P.O., 85 Years Old, Succumbs

Joseph W. Palmer, one of the oldest residents of the Seat Pleasant, Md., neighborhood, died Saturday at the home of his son, George N. Palmer, at Seat Pleasant Md., aged eighty-five years. The funeral will be held tomorrow from the Seat Pleasant Methodist Church. The interment will be in Congressional cemetery of this city.

For forty years Mr. Palmer was connected with the government printing office, resigning from that service fifteen years ago. He was one of the founders of the Seat Pleasant Methodist Church and an active worker in that congregation, being superintendent emeritus of the Sunday school. He was widely known among the older men and women employed at the big government printshop and among the printers of the city generally.

He is survived by his wife Mrs. Mary Palmer; two sons, George N. Palmer and Joseph Palmer, and two daughters, Mrs. Virginia Duvall and Mrs. Adelaide Barnes.
