
## **Thomas Harman Patterson**

## Death of Admiral Patterson

## He Passes Away Today at His Residence in this City

Rear Admiral Thomas H. Patterson, retired, died at his residence, 2100 G street, today. He died from exhaustion consequent upon a long illness.

The funeral will take place tomorrow afternoon from his residence. It will be strictly private.

He was sixty-nine years of age. He entered the service in 1836 from Louisiana and was retired in 1877. He saw nearly twenty-three years of sea service and was nearly the same length of time on shore duty. He had been for many years a resident of this city, where he had a large circle of friends.
