Dies After Collapse

Mrs. Emma Peake Fatally Stricken on Way to Doctor's Office

Stricken ill near 13th and T streets yesterday, Mrs. Emma Peake, sixty-six years old, 56 S street, died shortly after reaching the Emergency Hospital.

Mrs. Peake, relatives said, was on her way to a doctor's office when she collapsed on the street. Dr. Carl Corley, 1769 Columbia road, hurried her to the hospital.

Mrs. Peake was born at Catonsville, Md., and had resided in Washington for more than forty years. She lived with her sister, Mrs. Millard F. Peake, at the S street address.
