Mrs. Martha E. Perrott, 77, widow of George Perrott, retired City Post Office employe, died suddenly Tuesday at her home, 414 Seward square S.E. Funeral services will b held tomorrow at 2 p.m. at Lee's funeral home, fourth street and Massachusetts avenue N.E., with burial in Congressional Cemetery.
