Anne Beal Peters, 80, a lifelong Washington resident who retired in the mid-1980s after more than 20 years as an economist with the Federal Reserve Board, died of cardiac arrest Feb. 20 at Sibley Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Peters was a graduate of Central High School and the University of Maryland.

In retirement she did volunteer work at the Episcopal Home for Children, Sibley Memorial Hospital and the National Cathedral.

Her marriage to Dr. Melville Peters ended in divorce.

Survivors include a son, Walter Todd Peters of Cape Cod, Mass; and two grandchildren.
