Funeral services for John E. Piggott, who died last Sunday, were held at his residence, 455 I street northwest, yesterday afternoon, Rev. Dr. C.S. Abbott officiated. The services at the grave were in charge of the G.A.R. Interment was in Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Piggott was born in Washington in 1841. He was appointed to a position in the Interior Department when a young man, and remained there until a few years ago, when he was transferred to the pension office, where he remained until his retirement two months ago. One daughter, Mrs. Oneida E. Bradley, and an adopted daughter, Mrs. Mary Teleger, survive him.
