President and Mrs. Harrison Attend the Services at the House

The funeral of Mrs. O.L. Pruden, wife of the assistant private secretary to the President, took place yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the residence, 317 Eleventh street southwest. The services were conducted by Rev. Dr. Addison, of the Episcopal Church, who preached a short but beautiful and touching sermon. The remains were followed to the Congressional Cemetery only by the family and immediate friends. The floral offerings were beautiful and appropriate, among them being some magnificent cut flowers from the President and Mrs. Harrison.

Among those at the house outside of the family were the President and Mrs. Harrison, Mrs. Dimmick, Mrs. Parker, Miss Alice B. Sanger, Col. W.H. Crook, Mr. E.F. Tibbotts, B.F. Montgomery, Mr. Warren Young, and Capt. Lefflar. After the services the President and his family returned at once to the White House.
