Funeral services for Charles C. Pursell, bookseller and stationer, who died early Tuesday morning, will be held at 2:30 today from Wright's chapel. Interment will be in congressional cemetery.

Mr. Pursell was born October 20, 1838. He attended one of the first public schools in Washington, situated in F street near Fifth street northwest.
