C.L. Pyne, 93, Retired Lawyer

Charles L. Pyne, 93, a retired lawyer and the grandson of a 19th century rector of St. John's Episcopal Church at Lafayette square, died Tuesday in New York.

A native of the District, Mr. Pyne practiced law in St. Louis and New York until his retirement 15 years ago.

The grandson of Dr. Smith Pyne, rector of St. John's from 1845 to 1864, Mr. Pyne received his LL.B. degree from Columbian College, now George Washington University, in 1892. He played football on the school's first team in 1890.

He leaves a sister-in-law, Mrs. Henry R. Pyne, 3211 Connecticut avenue N.W.
