Death of a Justice of the Peace

This morning, about one o'clock, John R. Queen, Esq., a highly esteemed citizen, died at his residence on Garrison street, Navy Yard, after an illness of about six weeks. Mr. Queen was a native of Washington, and had occupied many important positions under the general and municipal governments with credit. He served during several years as the intendant of the city Asylum, and later as a Justice of the Peace, and was officiating in that capacity when his last illness forced him to leave his office. Mr. Queen was about 51 years of age.
