Charles E. Quigley Dies; Prominent D.C. Attorney

Charles E. Quigley, prominent Washington attorney, died yesterday at Sibley Hospital after a brief illness. He was 60 years old.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow at the Eckington Presbyterian Church, where Mr. Quigley was a trustee. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Quigley, a native of Washington, had practiced law here for 35 years, maintaining an office in the Westory Building. He was a Mason, member of the District Bar Association, Chevy Chase Citizens' Association and the Board of Trade.

Mr. Quigley who made his home at 6218 Thirtieth street N.W., is survived by his widow, Mrs. Emma Grace Quigley; two sons, Max E., and Lt. Bruce S. Quigley, U.S.N.; a brother, Arthur Quigley, and a sister, Miss Mary A. Quigley, both of the District.
