Buried Beside Her Husband

Yesterday the funeral of Mrs. Mary Ann Quincy took place from her late residence, 1525 5th street northwest, and was largely attended. The deceased, under her maiden name of Mary Ann Fuden, was a public school teacher in this city for many years. She was also one of the original members of the Calvary Baptist church. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Dr. S.H. Greene, of that church, who spoke of her faithfulness as school teacher and in the Sabbath School, and of her constant Christian life, which closed with her saying to her pastor: "It's all right." The remains were taken to Congressional Cemetery and interred beside her deceased husband.
