J.S. Ratrie, Government Engineer 18 Years, Dies

John S. Ratrie, 42, a structural engineer with the District and Federal Governments for the last 8 years died yesterday at his home, 5926 Thirteenth place N.W., after an illness of several months.

At the time of his death, Mr. Ratrie was employed in the Municipal Architects's Office, where he had worked for a year and a half. He had been employed earlier by several Federal Government organizations, including the Federal Works Agency and the Veterans' Administration.

A native of Spencer, W. Va., he was a graduate of West Virginia University and worked as chief engineer in a Charleston (W. Va.) chemical company before coming to Washington.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Carline S. Ratrie; three daughters, Mrs. Mary Bedford, New Orleans, La., and Miss Alice A. Ratrie, 15, and Carline M. Ratrie, 8, both of the Thirteenth place address; and his mother, Mrs. Adelaide Ratrie, Cleveland, Ohio.
