William Reinburg Dead

Employe of Government Printing Office Suddenly Expires

Mr. William Reinburg, an employe of the government printing office, as announced in The Star, died very suddenly of acute indigestion while at his desk yesterday. Mr. Reinburg has been a life-long resident of Washington, was known as a man of unimpeachable character and held in the highest esteem by a host of friends, to whom his death yesterday came as a great shock. The deceased was a brother of John Reinburg and of the late Louis Reinburg, both of this city, and a brother-in-law of ex-Gov. Arthur L. Thomas of Utah. His wife and six children survive him.

The funeral will occur tomorrow at 3:30 p.m. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
