Police to Attend Funeral

Services for Conrad Reinhard to Be Held Monday

Members of the Policemen's Association will attend the funeral of Policeman Conrad Reinhard, of the Fourth precinct, at the residence, 342 K street southwest, Monday, at 2. Reinhard died Thursday night after an illness of 24 hours. He had been on duty the day before his death.

Reinhard was a native of Washington, and was born March 14, 1865. He was appointed on the police force February 10, 1897, having previously been a member of the District fire department. He is survived by a wife and three children.
