Poison Proves Fatal

Coroner Decides Mrs. Grace Reynolds Committed Suicide

Mrs. Grace Reynolds, thirty-two years old, who was taken to the Casualty Hospital from her home, 127 E street northwest, a week ago and treated for mercury poisoning, died last night about 8:30 o'clock. When taken to the hospital it was said she had swallowed the poison by mistake.

Coroner Nevitt was told today that she had taken the poison with suicidal intent. Last Saturday she went to a drug store and purchased the poison. She became ill and was sent to the hospital.

There was an apparent improvement in her condition the next day, and it was thought she would recover, but a change for the worse followed. Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of death by suicide.
