Thrown From His Wagon and Killed

Monday afternoon Mr. Lorenzo Rice, while driving a young horse, was thrown from his carriage at the corner of 6th and C streets southwest. His head struck the curb and he was picked up in an unconscious condition. He was taken to his home, 490 Maine avenue, and died last evening without recovering consciousness. Mr. Rice was 86 years of age and had been a resident of this city since 1869. He was engaged in the carpet-cleaning business.
